## OBITUARY

Burnette Jane Domier, 95, beloved mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and great great-grandmother, passed away peacefully on June 28, 2024, at the Guardian Angels Care Center in Elk River, MN, under the care of Hospice.

Burnette was born on October 5, 1928 in Portland, ND, the daughter of Bennie and Bertha Grandalen. She was baptized and confirmed at Aurdal Lutheran Church. She graduated from Portland High School in 1946.
